OCMAD CODE YELLOW EXERCISE

Drill June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013

8:00am to 12:30pm

Scenario: Code Yellow.

Bomb is detonated at Lakeview Community Hospital in Anaheim at 0800 which results in evacuation of hospital due to damage and possibly of other bombs. Each participating hospital will receive patients from the evacuated hospital. In addition each participating hospital will receive a phone in bomb threat and will need to activate their code yellow policy.

Please note that the drill will begin and the Labor pool will become active up in Café A & B in Newport. Kent and Thomas will available to open the labor pool in Newport and Ryan Stomp will manage the Labor pool at HHI/HOI.
