### Hoag on the Move: 10th Floor Sub ICU

Hoag Hospital Newport Beach Sub ICU is excited to announce the recent completion of the tenth floor renovation project. The floor features 27 patient rooms, a redesigned clinical station, a large shared medication room and a Telemetry Command Center.

Upgrades to the existing patient rooms include new flooring, wall finishes, paint, artwork, patient/visitor wardrobe and additional built-in shelving. The floor also features 22 hemodialysis capable rooms and two A.I.R. beds.

In addition to the renovated rooms, there is an updated staff break room, locker room, and restroom.

Please review the attached floorplan showing the new tenth floor layout and make the appropriate changes in staffing to support the new Sub ICU. Patients and staff will move to the tenth floor on Monday and Tuesday, November 26-27.
